#### PLACES TO VISIT IN HYDERABAD:-

- (1) GOLKONDA FORT:— At a distance of 13 KMs from Hyderabad is a magnificent structure that reflects the genius of its builders with walled enclosures and places on the hillock. The fort is well known for its acoustics and its ingenious water supply. The sage of Golconda is uniquely depicted every evening at 06.30 pm and 07.30 pm through sound & light show that takes us through golden days of Golconda with voice over by Mr.Amitabh Bachchan, Film Actor.
- (2) <u>SALARJUNG MUSEUM:-</u> This museum houses one of the biggest on-man collections of antiques of the world by Mir Yousuf Ali Khan, Salar Jung III. The objects d'art include Persian carpets, Mughal miniatures, Chinese porcelain, Japanese lacquerware, famous statues including the Veiled Rebecca and Marguerite and Mephistopheles, a superb collection of jade, daggers belonging to Queen Noor Jahan and the Emperors Jahangir and Shah Jahan & Aurangzeb's sword.
- (3) CHOWMOHALLA PALACE:— The magnificent Chowmahalla Palace was the seat of the Asaf Jahi dynasty where the Nizams entertained their official guests and royal visitors. Built over 200 years ago, Chowmahalla Palace is renowned for its unique style and elegance. A synthesis of many architectural styles and influences.
- (4) CHARMINAR:— Mohammed Quli Quth Shah, the founder of Hyderabad, built Chalrminar in 1591 at the centre of original City layout. Four graceful minarets soar to a height of 48.7 m above the ground. Charminar has 45 prayer spaces and a mosque in it. Visitors can view the architectural splendor inside the Charminar. The monument is illuminated in the evenings with dynamic lighting.
- (4) TARAMATI BARADARI:— The 17<sup>th</sup> century monument built for the court musician revived to its own old glory. A cultural complex created around the illuminated monument is a new tourist attraction. The facilities here include Hotel, Restaurant, Bar, Conference Hall, Swimming Pool apart from the Open Air Theatre and an Indoor Auditorium.
- (5) QUTUB SHAHI TOMBS:— The Tombs of the legendary Qutub Shahi Kings lie about a kilometer away from Banjara Darwaza of the Golconda Fort. These tombs form a large group and stand on a raised platform. The tombs are built in Persian. Pathan and the Hindu architectural system using grey granite with stucco ornamentation. This oldest historical monument is one of its kind in the world where an entire dynasty has been buried at one place.

- (6) NEHRU ZOOLOGICAL PARK:— Spanning 300 lush green acres, the Nehru Zoological Park is a must for nature lovers. It has over 250 species of animals and birds, most of which are kept in conditions as close to their natural habitats as possible. This is first zoo to create mooted enclosures for animals. The Lion Safari Park, Natural History Museum and Children's Train are the added attractions.
- (7) <u>LUMBHINI PARK</u>:— This beautiful park is situated on the shore of Hussainsagar lake. The landscaping here is a visual treat. A musically synchronized water fountain and a floral clock are major attractions here. Lumbini Park jetty is a major point for pleasure boating to Budha Statue.
- (8) NTR GARDENS:— A leisure and entertainment centre adjoining the Hussainsagar lake, the NTR Gardens on the Necklace Road.

#### PLACES TO VISIT IN TELANGANA STATE

- (1) YADAGIRIGUTTA TEMPLE:- Lakshmi Narasimha Swamy Temple 62 KMs from Hyderabad.
- (2) KULPAKJI JAIN TEMPLE: The Kulpakji Temple 78 KMs from Hyderabad and it is also known as "Shri Shwetambar Jain Tirth".
- (3) NAGARJUNA SAGAR DAM: \_ 153 KMs from Hyderabad is considered one of the largest dams built in the recent times in Asia.
- (4) SRIPARVATA ARAMA (BUDDHAVANAM):—146 KMs from Hyderabad is located in an extent of 274 acres of land on the left Bank of river Krishna and divided into eight sigments.
- (5) JOGULAMBA TEMPLE: 222 KMs from Hyderabad, at Alampur is one of the 18 Shakthipeetas. The principal deities are Jogulamba and Balabrahmeshwara.

Nearby is the Navabrahma Temples, a group of 9 temples dedicated to Shiva. A short distance away is the Papanashanam Temple complex.

(6) GADWAL FORT: - 191 KMs from Hyderabad was built by Peda Soma Bhupaludu, the ruler of the Gadwal Samasthanam (1703-1710).

(7) ANATHAGIRI HILLS:— 81 KMs from Hyderabad, poor men's Ooti in summer – it is considered as one of the dense forests in Telangana Region.

Nearby is the **Ananthapadmanabha Swamy Temple** 78 KMs from Hyderabad dedicated to worship Lord Vishnu.

- (8) CHILKUR BALAJI TEMPLE: 28 KMs from Hyderabad is located on the banks of the Osman Sagar Lake.
- (9) MEDAK FORT: Methukudurgam, as the Medak Fort 95 KMs from Hyderabad was known earlier, is on a hillock at a height of 1450 feet. Prataprudra of the Kakatiya Dynasty, built this Fort in the 12<sup>th</sup> Century BC.

At an hour's ride is the **Singoor Dam** (96 KMs from Hyderabad) that is built on the river Manjeera.

- (10) EDUPAYALA DURGA BHAVANI TEMPLE: 95 KMs from Hyderabad is dedicated to Goddess Kanaka Durga.
- (11) MEDAK CHURCH:— 97 KMs from Hyderabad, set in a sprawling compound, has a length of 200 feet and is 100 feet wide. The main tower is 175 feet.
- (12) <u>DICHPALLY RAMALAYAM:-</u> 161 KMs from Hyderabad, a fort temple in Nizamabad district is said to have been built during the Kakatiyan rule.
- (13) ALI SAGAR RESERVOIR: \_ 191 KMs from Hyderabad, located in Janakampet village in Nizamabad District.
- (14) <u>BADA PAHAD DURGA:</u> 171 KMs from Hyderabad, a Muslim Pilgrim Centre is located in Bada Pahad village 43 KMs from Nizamabad.
- (15) GNANA SARSWATHI DEVI TEMPLE BASAR: 207 KMs from Hyderabad is the presiding deity. The idol is bedecked with turmeric.
- (16) KUNTALA WATERFALLS: 270 KMs from Hyderabad 100 metres wide and fall from about 40 meters are the largest waterfalls in South India.

- (17) GAYATRI WATERFALLS: 270 KMs from Hyderabad are deep inside the forest and require trekking of about 5 KMs.
- (18) KAWAL WILDLIFE SANCTUARY: 295 KMs from Hyderabad was established in 1964 and presently covers an area of nearly 200 sq KMs.
- (19) KONDAGATTU ANJENEYA SWAMY TEMPLE:- 146 KMs from Hyderabad the temple is rectangular in shape and has a very functional architecture.

Around 50 KMs from Kondagattu is **Dharmapuri – Lakshni Narasimha Swamy** (229 KMs from Hyderabad) a temple town on the banks of the river Godavari. Dharmapuri is one of the sites for the Godavari Pushkaralu.

Kotilingala is a Hindu pilgrimage site in Jagithyal – traditional Shiva Temple.

- (20) VEMULAWADA TEMPLE: The Raja Rajeshwara Temple 150 KMs from Hyderabad at Vemulawada is among the most popular Shiva Temples in the State of Telangana.
- (21) <u>FLAGANDAL FORT</u>: 20 KMs from Vemulawada and 180 KMs fro Hyderabad. The Fort is thought to be built during the Kakatiya period, but later it was under the Qutub Shahis, Moghuls and the Nizams.
- (22) KALESHWARA MUKTESHWARA SWAMY TEMPLE :- 262 KMs from Hyderabad a Temple that is unique with two Shivlingas.

The **prestigious irrigation project** of Telangana is at Kaleshwaram said to be the biggest irrigation project in the world.

- (23) KEESARGUTTA TEMPLE :- 39 KMs from Hyderabad, famous for its Shiva Temple, built in South Indian architectural style.
- (24) WARANGAL FORT: \_\_150 KMs from Hyderabad, in the early 13<sup>th</sup> century the imposing Warangal Fort was a sprawling complex comprising of 7 forts, 360 wells and 360 temples.

Near the Warangal Fort is the **Thousand Pillar Temple** intricately carved pillars are ploaced with geometrical precision in main Mandapa and the Kalyana Mandapa.

The **Bhadrakali Temple** located close, is one of the oldest shrines of its kind in India. Built in 625 BC by the Chalukya King, this temple lies next to the Bhadrakali Lake.

(25) PAKHAL LAKE: 240 KMs from Hyderabad is a man-made lake which was built during Kakatiya rule. This lake was built in 1213 AD by the Kakatiya King Ganapati Deva.

**Pakhal Wildlife Sanctuary**: The sanctuary covers an area of 839 sq KM and is bestowed with rare flora and fauna.

(26) LAKNAVARAM LAKE: 216 KMs from Hyderabad, cover an area of 10,000 acres. The Kakatiyas constructed a sluice gate to control the flow of water thereby converting the lake as a water source for irrigation. There are 13 islands in the lake and three of them are connected by a suspension bridge. Another suspension bridge was brought into use - TGTDC has a lake resort on one of the islands and also runs boat cruise on the lake.

40 KMs from Laknavaram, is the **Eturnagaram Wildlife Sanctuary** - The river Godavari passes through the Sanctuary, which is spread in an area of over 800 sq KMs.

20 KMs from Laknavaram is Medaram, where the biennial Samakka SDaralamma Jatara is held. The jatara is a classic example of the Indian tradition of celebrating its rebels and warriors.

(27) RAMAPPA TEMPLE: \_ 208 KMs from Hyderabad – constructed in 1173 BC during the reign of Kakatiya King Ganapati Deva, is perhaps the only temple known by its architect than the deity Rudreshwara.

Ramappa Lake :- close by was also built by the Kakatiya Kings.

**Pandavula Guhalu**:- (near Ramappa) these caves are in the thickly forested hillock in Narsapur village. In these caves are extraordinary murals dating back in the 9-10 centuary.

(28) BADRACHALAM TEMPLE:— 312 KMs from Hyderabad— is said to be a part of the Dandakaryana Forest where Lord Rama, Laxamana and Sita crossed through their 14 year exile. The temple in Bhadrachalam is closely connected with the life of the 17<sup>th</sup> Centuary saint composer Kancharla Gopanna who was known as Bhakta Ramada.

**Parnasala**:- The spot where Lord Rama along with Sita and Brother Laxmana stayed during their exile.

**Kinnerasani Wild Life Sanctuary** is nearby and offers nature lovers a wide variety of flora and fauna.

(29) <u>SRISAILAM:</u>—Sri sailam is a pilgrim destination of supreme significance — find serenity for the soul and experience sublime spiritual peace in divine surrounds. Nallamala forests is the magnificent 12<sup>th</sup> century temple of Lord Mallikarjuna Swamy and Bhramarambha.

On the way to Srisailam, 1.5 KMs from temple is a shrine of Lord Vinayaka. The deity here is known as Sakshi Ganapati, as he is said to be recording the visit of pilgrims to the Mallikarjuna Swamy Temple, as Lord Shiva's witness.

(30) SOMASILA:— The ancient 7<sup>th</sup> century Someswara Swamy temple at Somasila, a highly revered shrine, situated 200 KMs from Hyderabad and 9 KMs from Kollapur in Mahabubnagar Dist.

(31) FARAHABAD:— This beautiful nature retreat is nestled among the forest of the Nallamala Hills in the Eastern Ghats at an altitude of ahout 914 m. Farahabad literally means 'Mount Pleasant' located in Mahabubnagar Dist.

(32) MALLELA THEERTHAM:— Another delightful sight on the route from Hyderabad to Srisailam is the Mallela Threertham, sparkling water fall located 50 KMs from Srisailam.

#### BUDDHIST SITES IN TELANGANA STATE

The advent of Buddhism into the Telangana Region is traced back to the very lifetime of the Buddha himself i.e., the 5 th Century BC. The presence of Assaka Janapada, part of present Telangana, as one of the 16 Maha Janapada in ancient India proves that there existed an advanced stage of society on par with advanced parts of the country.

- 1) PHANIGIRI:- The Buddhist site at Phanigiri is located on a hill top about 45 KMs from Suryapet Dist., 110 KMs from Hyderabad.
- 2) BADANAKURTHI:- It is an island in the river Godavari 6 KMs from Khanapur Mandal in Nirmal Dist, where Bavari lived in hermitage in Kavitavanam.
- 3)KOTALINGAALA:- It is on the right bank of the river Godavari in Velgatoor Mandal and is situated about 19 KMs from Dharmapuri and 52 KMs from Karimnagar.
- 4) DHULIKATTA: Dhulikatta or Dhulikota (Mud Fort) 16 KMs from Peddapally Dist. It is an extensive early historic site encompassed by a mud fort with brick built gateways.
- 5)KONDAPUR: Kodapur village and Mandal is situated in Sangareddy Dist at a distance of 60 KMs from Hyderabad on Hyderabad-Mumbai highway.
- 6)NELAKONDAPALLI:- It is a road side village in Khammam Dist familiarly known as the birth place of the Saint Kancherla Gopanna (Baktha Ramdas).
